#### Call to Confession (Colossians 1:20)

Leader: We turn to God in praise and prayer, not from a position of power and strength, but from the broken edges of our lives, from the broken edges of the world and the church.

**People:** *We offer our prayers of confession, trusting in the One who is reconciling all things.*

Leader: Let us pray together . . .

#### Prayer of Confession (Luke 17:5-11)

*God of grace, You seek to grow new things within us. We confess that we don't give you much to work with. The seed of faith is small within us. Hope is hard to muster. Love is often inconvenient. Our brokenness keeps us from responding to you.*

*Have mercy on us. Stir us, empower us, redeem us, so that we might reach to you and move toward you, and grow in the ways of faith, hope and love. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen.*

#### Assurance of Pardon (II Timothy 1)

Leader: God, in Christ Jesus, grants us peace, mercy and peace. Let us hold to the sound teaching of the faith: that God has the power to save us, and has given us grace through all ages.

**People:** *We receive the treasure of faith entrusted to us, with the help of the Holy Spirit living in us. Thanks be to God!*
