Preparation for the Word

The Call to Worship (Psalm 22:1-15)

Leader: My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? and are so far from my cry and from the words of my distress?

People: *O my God, I cry in the daytime, but you do not answer; by night as well, but I find no rest.*

Leader: Yet you are the Holy One, enthroned upon the praises of Israel.

People: *Our ancestors put their trust in you; they trusted, and you delivered them.*

Leader: They cried out to you and were delivered; they trusted in you and were not put to shame.

People: *But as for me, I am a worm and not a man, scorned by all and despised by the people.*

Leader: All who see me laugh me to scorn; they curl their lips and wag their heads, saying,

People: *“He trusted in the LORD; let the LORD deliver him; let God rescue him, if God delights in him.”*

Leader: Yet you are the one who took me out of the womb, and kept me safe upon my mother's breast.

People: *I have been entrusted to you ever since I was born; you were my God when I was still in my mother's womb.*

Leader: Be not far from me, for trouble is near, and there is none to help.

People: *Many young bulls encircle me; strong bulls of Bashan surround me.*

Leader: They open wide their jaws at me, like a ravening and a roaring lion.

People: *I am poured out like water; all my bones are out of joint; my heart within my breast is melting wax.*

All: *My mouth is dried out like a pot-sherd; my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth; and you have laid me in the dust of the grave.*
