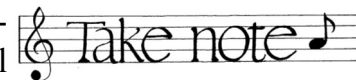
•Due to Pastor David being on vacation the Adult Sunday School Class will not meet next Sunday, June 5th and on Sunday, June 12th.

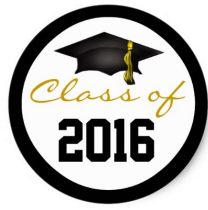
