Bethel Youth with the assistance of adults would like to invite you to a Sunrise Worship Service at Bethel's Chapel in the woods at 6:30 am on Easter morning. Derek Almarode will be the speaker. We would like to continue the tradition of having the service with breakfast to follow. Please bring your favorite breakfast dishes prepared and ready to share after the service. We had 80 people attend last year and would like to exceed that number this year.

•John and Wallace Pilson have donated two historical items to Bethel. The documents were passed down to them from their ancestor, Matthew Pilson, who served as an elder at Bethel from 1804 to 1822. One document is Matthew Pilson's personal recollection of Bethel's origin: our separation from Brown's Meeting House. The other is a ledger which contains the handwritten records of two early Bethel organizations: the Bethel Temperance Society and the Committee of Bethel Library. The Temperance Society records begin with the formation of the Society on December 26, 1831 and continue through January 14, 1838. They were written by Matthew Pilson, who was the secretary of the Society. The Library section of the ledger is a record of the minutes of the Committee's meetings and detail the formation of the library on August 8, 1846, continue through August 29, 1863 and were also written by Matthew Pilson.We at Bethel are extremely grateful to John and Wallace Pilson for these gifts. They are a priceless addition to our collection of historical artifacts and also to our knowledge of Bethel's history. Our heartfelt thanks are extended to the Pilsons for their generosity. These items will be on display in Memorial Hall, before and after worship, on March 25th and on Easter Sunday, April 1st.

•LETTER FROM THE DIACONATE (ACTION APPROVED BY SESSION-MARCH 11, 2018)
