Graham Cracker Treats

Break graham crackers in to 4's and lay on ungreased cookie sheet

Melt -1 stick butter, 1 stick margarine, 1/2 cup sugar

Bring to a boil

Add 1/2 cup chopped pecans

Pour mixture over graham crackers and bake at 350 for 12-14 minutes

Take out of pan as soon as they stiffen
