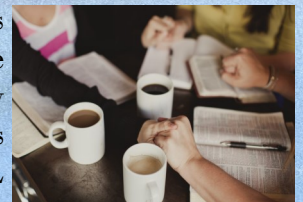
The flowers in the Sanctuary today are given to the Glory of God by Drury Whitaker.
