Many of you know or may remember Dennis Russell who is the former Pastor at St. John's Reformed Church and his wife, Sarah. Pastor Dennis has also preached at Bethel as a Guest Speaker, has led several community worship services, and both he and Sarah are active in the local community.

Baby Havilah was admitted to the NICU at less than 24 hours old because she was not eating.
