#### MESSAGE OF THE WEEK

I hope that everyone is doing well. The following is one of my favorite scripture passages. I think it is relevant at this time. With the social distancing and protests, everyone's life is quite different now. We need to consider how we can improve our relationships in our church, community and others with whom we come into contact. We need to put our faith in God and know that he has a plan for all of us.

## 1 Corinthians 13 verses 1-7 & 13

If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing.

Love is patient, love is kind, it does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoice with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.
