Canned Vegetables (3 cans) Cranberry Sauce (1 container) Condiments (salt, pepper) Drink Mix/Tea/Coffee (1) Pie Filling (1-2) Pie Crust (1-2) Dry Milk/Canned Milk (10 oz box or 2 cans)
