

Informational meetings with the Listening Committee were held on July 6th, 2021 and July 13th, 2021. At these meetings attendees were told there will be a called meeting of the Bethel Congregation in the near future. This meeting will be scheduled for late this summer or early fall and the findings of the committee will be presented. There will then be a vote as to what Bethel's future will hold. 



#### Mission Committee

#### SUMMERLEE MISSION PROJECT, 2021

Due to the continuation of the Covid-19 pandemic the Summerlee Mission Project was focused and centered around sites which were local to Augusta County, VA as was done in year 2020. The location of the sites were four in Waynesboro, two in Staunton, one in Greenville and one at the Craigsville Presbyterian Church Food & Clothes Pantry.

During the days of July 12th, 2021 – July 16th, 2021, approximately 75 participants from nine churches made building repairs that were finished within the budgeted time. Those participating churches included Bethel, Westminster Presbyterian (Waynesboro), Bethesda Presbyterian (Rockbridge Baths), Front Royal Presbyterian (Front Royal), Jerusalem Chapel Seventh Day Adventist (Churchville), Mt Horeb Presbyterian (Grottoes), Second Presbyterian (Waynesboro), Smyrna Presbyterian (Waynesboro), and Tinkling Spring Presbyterian (Fishersville).

The scope of repairs for the individual homes included construction of an entry door ramp, roof repairs, exterior painting, electrical repairs, replacement of window glass, rehanging of entry doors, weed eating and removal of trees and shrubs, acoustical ceiling work, overhead door replacement, new storage shelving, siding repair and doorbell installation.


Typical work hours were 7:30 am to 5:30 pm. The consolidated church group provided dinner on Wednesday evening at Westminster Presbyterian.


