Bethel and has preached here many times before. He always does a fabulous job and we appreciate his will-ingness to help out with the worship service (again)!

Rev. Brownlee grew up in Rockbridge Baths, Virginia, and moved back there 10 years ago to retire. He has been pastor of churches in Hazard, Kentucky; Riverdale, Georgia; and Huntersville, North Carolina, and interim pastor of churches in Lexington, North Carolina; Beckley, West Virginia; and Fairfield and Rockbridge Baths, Virginia. From 1973 till 1984 he and his wife Sarah were missionaries in Indonesia. Bethel was one of their supporting churches during that time.

OUTDOORS: Comfy Chair, Writing Tablet, Pen and/or Pencil, and Bible


INSIDE: Writing Tablet, Pen and/or Pencil, and Bible


