THE IMPORTANCE OF STUDYING THE BIBLE

Making Time for God's Word

Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. – Joshua 1:8

In our busy lives, it can be easy to neglect reading the bible. We may go to church, listen to Christian music, read a devotional, and pray, but are we making time to read and study the word of God? God's words are powerful and provide direction and hope for our lives. To obtain the benefits of God's word, we must constantly study the Bible to strengthen our faith.

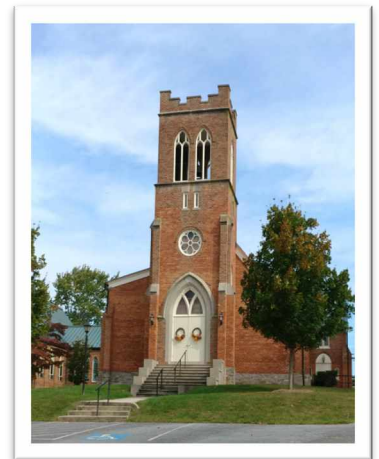
No Excuses

Putting Bible Study into Action

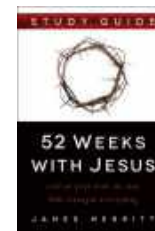
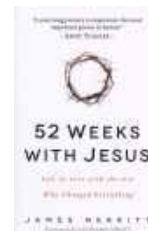
