WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY OCTOBER 3RD, 2021

Communion will be Received

Bethel will once again make our own disposable (fresh) elements using plastic cups for communion. Please pick up one of each, juice and bread, as you arrive at the worship service. Follow Rev. Bangley's instructions during the "Invitation to the Lord's Table" which will be noted in your Order of Worship. Gluten free elements will also be available, please only take one if you have gluten sensitivities or an allergy.

Elders will not be handing out the elements.

Trash bins will be available as you leave for the used cups. Elders will be present on each side and in the back of the chapel area to assist if needed.

On October 3rd, congregations around the globe will celebrate World Communion Sunday. This special day originated in 1936 in the Presbyterian Church and was adopted by the Federal Council of Churches (predecessor of the NCC) in 1940. Since then, the celebration has grown into an international ecumenical celebration of Christian unity.

World Communion Sunday is a time for remembering that around the globe—in different languages, with different traditions and customs, and in various forms of liturgy—the Lord's Supper is celebrated through—out Christendom. At its best, therefore, World Communion Sunday serves two purposes: it is both a joyous and meaningful partaking in Jesus' sacred meal with his friends and a mind-opening exposure to different Christian traditions from around the world.

The children will enjoy receiving our gift cards for Christmas.
