Have you ever thought how blessed you are to be you. I have, even with all my faults, I have been blessed. Week five - we walk in Hope. Can we walk at all? How is your posture? Are you standing tall ready to take on the world or bent over ready to crumble? Jesus is our strength - trust Him.

This brings us to Holy Week with its ups and downs. We all know the scriptures and what Jesus went through. Thankfully, it ends on a high note. Or does it end? As our author says, we "have work to do. A new road needs to be made." Let us walk this road together in HOPE and LOVE, standing up for what we believe and always PRAYING for God's guidance.
