

Dear Bethel Family,

On September 13, 2020 the Bethel Session took executive action and requested that the church be granted "Gracious Dismissal" from Shenandoah Presbytery and the Presbyterian Church of the United States of America (PCUSA).

Following presbyterian polity and our current book of order the Shenandoah Presbytery formed a listening committee to speak with the Bethel family. Following their findings, the listening committee transformed themselves into the Administrative Commission. At which time the Session authorized and formed an Administrative Committee on Transition to manage and negotiate terms of dismissal with Shenandoah Presbytery.

The two commissioned groups worked diligently towards an amicable resolution. After several inperson meetings and exhaustive independent work by the committees they both met in-person on January 12, 2023 for one final time. The purpose of this meeting was to negotiate a financial settlement to transfer the Bethel Deed of Trust held by the Presbyterian Church of the United States of America back to Bethel Presbyterian Church. At that meeting a formal resolution for separation and dismissal was drafted and agreed upon. On January 29, 2023, the Bethel Congregation met and voted unanimously in support of that resolution for dismissal.

On February 28, 2023 during a full Presbytery meeting of the Shenandoah Presbytery via Zoom, the Resolution for Dismissal went before the floor of the Presbytery as a motion. The motion had no discussion and the vote from the Presbytery floor was unanimous. Thus, we have been formally and officially dismissed by the Shenandoah Presbytery and the Presbyterian Church of the United States of America.

Congratulations, to all of you for your extraordinary patience, love, fortitude and service to our beautiful Bethel. Following the actions of our legal council all Bethel holdings, to include, but not limited to, our real-estate, our finances, our name, our historical documents, our personal property, and our organizational structure will be transferred in the Circuit Court of Augusta County. On behalf of the Administrative Committee on Transition and the Bethel Session, we thank you from the bottom of our hearts.

In our 277th year as a family in faith, Bethel steps out on new footing in the ministry of Jesus Christ, Effective, March 5, 2023, Bethel is now affiliated with the East Central Presbytery of a Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians, hereafter referred to as ECO,

Please come and join us, for Sunday worship during our normal worship hour and celebrate our inaugural year as Covenant Partners in ECO. Today, we celebrate a new benchmark in Bethel's history. Tomorrow is a new day in our service to Christ Jesus. No time to waste, we hope to see you on Sunday mornings.

- Meeting was closed with prayer by John Craft. Thanks to him for his service as Moderator!
