

A MESSAGE FROM THE PULPIT

It is hard to believe, but here we are in March, how did we get here so fast? It seems like yesterday that we just celebrated Christmas. Maybe it is because I am older, but I can't remember time moving so fast. Recalling my younger years forces me to remember things and events of the past. "Remembering", is something we as Christians do in the season s of Lent, Holy Week and Easter.

As we look back on our busy lives, how often are we called upon to remember important details that have molded our lives and made us who we are today?
