

- Notes of Importance for the Congregation –

- · Session met April 21, May 19 and June 9, including our new Elders, we set up our year with Committee Chairman as follows: Continuing Education, Tim Turner; Youth Cindy Almarode; Witness and Missions; Outreach, Evangelism, and Communication, Penny Lee; Property and Maintenance, Wade Cash; Stewardship and Finance, Brian Lee; Worship, Tammy Barbour and Penny Lee, Congregational Care, Mark Wade; Personnel, David Schooley. From the Deacons, Wade Cash presented a quote to replace the Window Treatments in the Fellowship Hall, this was Tabled until our June Meeting. The Bethel Annual report was presented and approved for printing and distribution to our Congregation. Wade also announced the lighting for the Flagpole and to light the Tower was completed. Our Graduates were recognized and presented their Bible. Youth Bible study was started with Pines, and all was reported as GOOD attendance, with meal before. Sadly, we announced the death of Larry Edwards and Yvonne Goodson, long time Bethel Members. We approved a request from Bob Olson for this year's Baha trip to share with the family directly. Started planning for our ECO fall Presbytery Meeting for October 18-19, with meals and other festivities. We will review plans at our July Session Meeting on July 21 at 1:00 pm.
- · Our biggest event was the May 26th Celebration, our first of the year outside service, followed by dedication of the Flagpole and the Stone, followed by a great Celebration Dinner supplied by several great cooks and great fellowship. With that it was a great Day!
- Homecoming will be August 25, with service inside and covered dish meal to follow, Bethel will supply the meat.
 Again, this year we will have Baptism at the river at Shenandoah Camping grounds Middle River August 18, at 11:00 AM with covered dish meal to follow. All are welcome, even wheelchairs can be handled.
